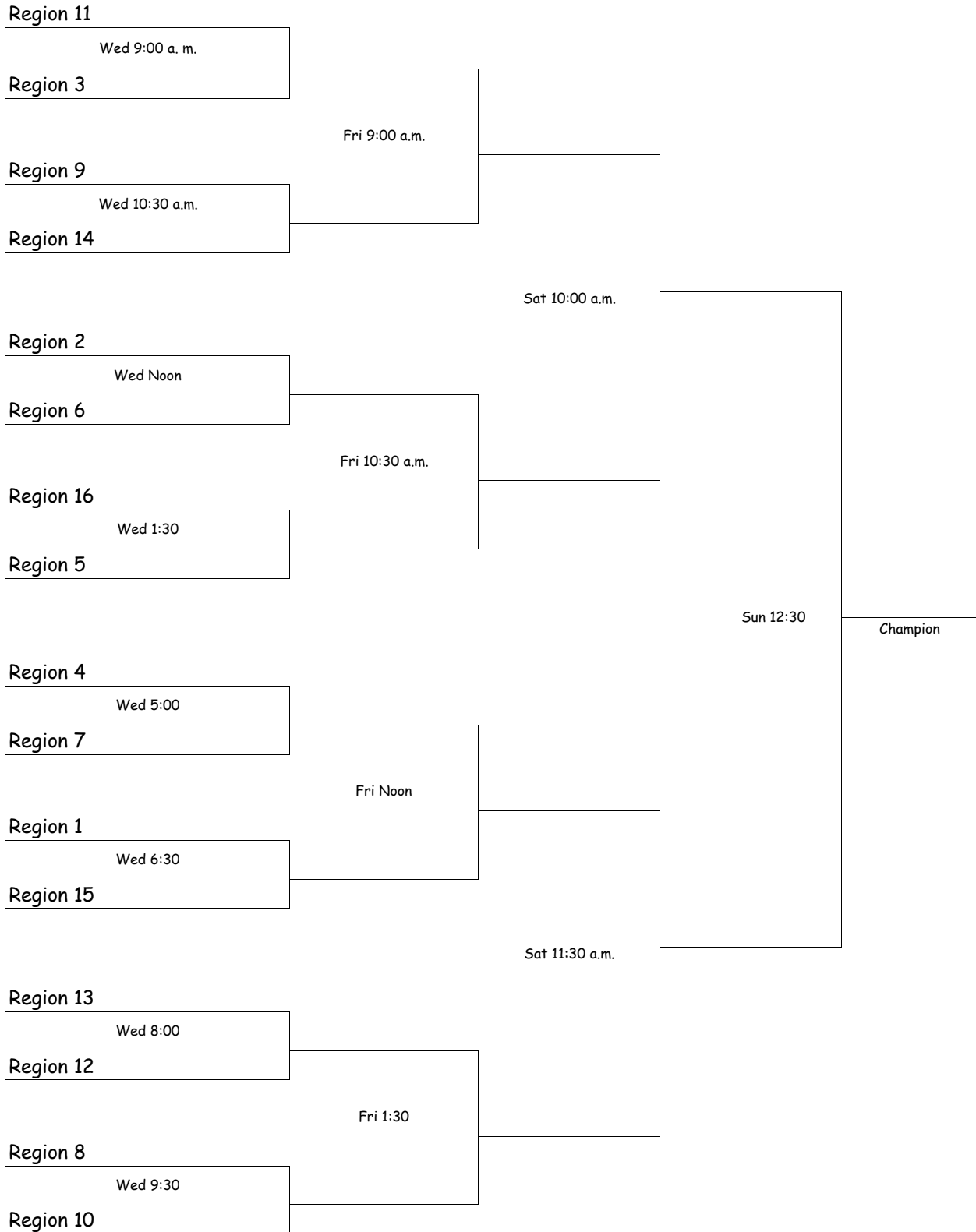
What is the Kentucky All "A" Classic?

1. The Kentucky All "A" Classic, Incorporated, is a corporation operated by its 125 member high schools with enrollments of 425 students or less in the upper three grades. The purpose of the organization is to promote programs that provide opportunities for students in these "small" high schools throughout Kentucky. The primary sponsor for the All "A" Classic is Touchstone Energy.
2. This is a program for youth, operated by individuals who care about young people, sponsored in part by companies and individuals who wish to provide positive opportunities for the youth of Kentucky.
3. The All "A" Classic is organized exclusively for the presentation of charitable, inspirational, and educational programs.
4. The All "A" Classic sponsors activities in athletics, academics, citizenship, and fellowship. What began as a nine-team boy's basketball tournament has grown into a statewide tournament for nearly 250 boys and girls basketball teams. Competition for academic teams was added in 1993, along with a statewide cheerleading competition and youth rally. The youth rally is open to the general public and features nationally known speakers. In 1997, a scholarship program and art competition was added to benefit even more All "A" students. In 1998, the All "A" Classic opened its own web site located at www.allaclassic.org and during 2002 a JROTC competition was added. A music competition was added in 2003. Statewide baseball and statewide fast pitch softball tournaments were implemented in 2004.
5. The All "A" Classic has no paid employees. The only individuals profiting from the programs offered through the All "A" Classic are students.
6. No portion of the net profit of the organization is distributed to members, trustees, officers, or other private persons with the exception that the organization is authorized and empowered to reimburse expenses for services rendered.
7. The organization does not discriminate on the basis of race, age, gender, or disability in regard to admissions, use of facilities or privileges, faculty or staff, scholarships, or other programs.

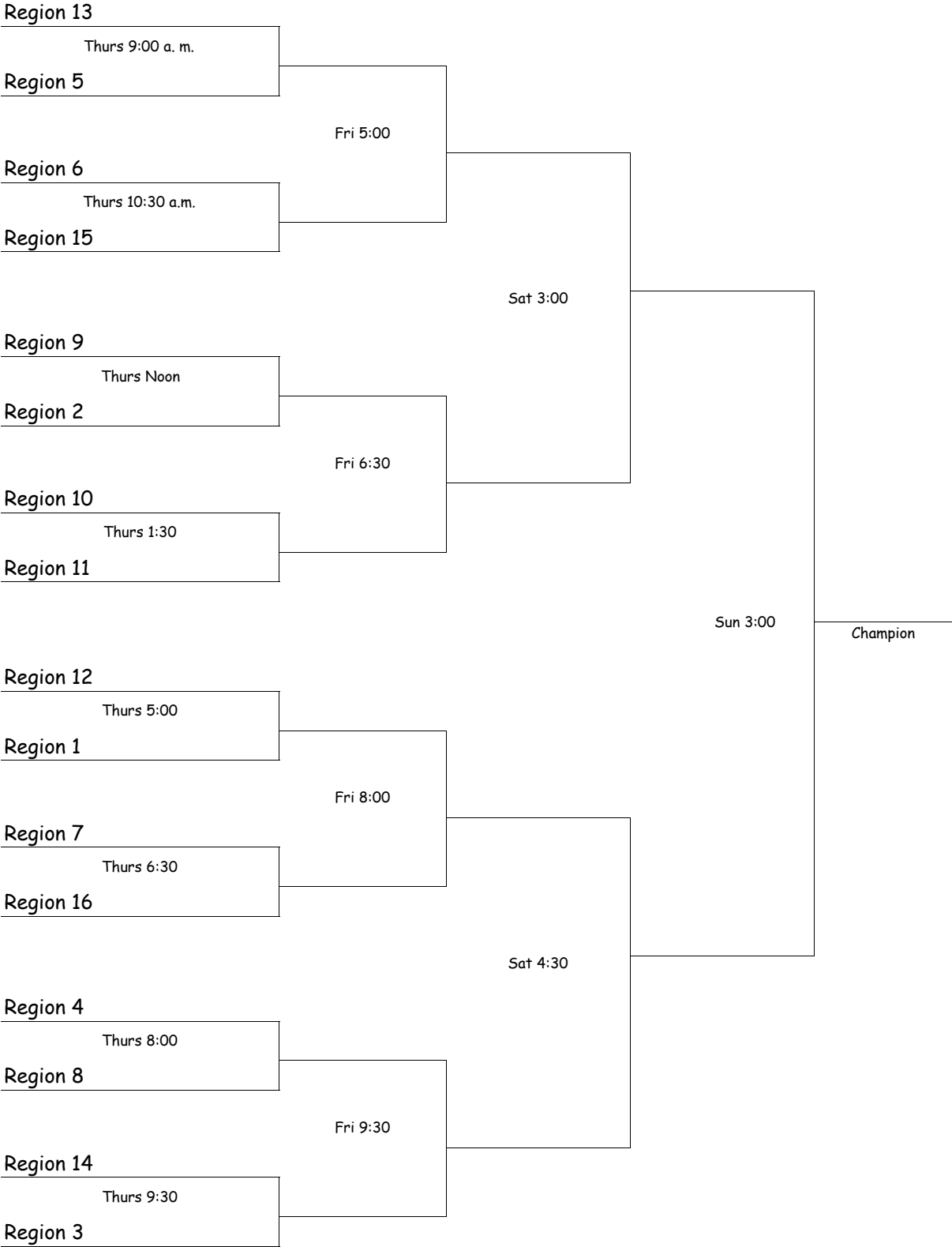
2008 Touchstone Energy All "A" Classic Basketball Tournament Fact Sheet

- The Touchstone Energy All "A" Classic is a statewide basketball tournament for schools with an enrollment of 425 students or less in grades 10-12. The winners from the 16 boys' regional tournaments along with the 16 girls' regional tournament champions will advance to the statewide tournament held in Richmond from January 30 - February 3.
- The purpose of the basketball tournament is to allow smaller high schools in Kentucky an opportunity to compete in basketball on a more equal basis, to showcase the athletes from smaller schools who sometimes do not get the same recognition as athletes from the larger high schools, and to offer the people of Kentucky another opportunity to enjoy quality basketball.
- The Touchstone Energy All "A" Classic is not only a basketball tournament, but also a full program for the smaller schools. In 2007-2008, the All "A" Classic will provide over 15,000 smaller school students with the opportunity to actively participate in a statewide academic scholarship competition, a scholarship program, an art competition, a music competition, statewide baseball tournament, statewide fast pitch softball tournament, and a cheerleading competition.
- The Touchstone Energy All "A" Classic strengthened its commitment to academics and education in 1996-97 by providing scholarship opportunities open to all students of Class "A" schools. In the first year of the scholarship program, twelve \$1,000 scholarships were awarded to Class "A" seniors planning to attend any Kentucky institution of higher education. The number of scholarships increased to a total of \$70,000 for 2002-2003. In addition, over \$5,000 of scholarships and awards are presented annually as part of the statewide academic and art competitions. This year the total amount of scholarships provided will exceed \$750,000.
- Of the 112 Class "A" schools that are members of the Kentucky High School Athletic Association, 112 boys' teams and 111 girls' teams have committed to participate in this year's Touchstone Energy All "A" Basketball Classic.
- Over 46,000 fans attended the 2007 Touchstone Energy All "A" Classic statewide tournament held at EKU's McBrayer Arena with an overall average of over 5,000 fans per session. The Lexington Christian Lady Eagles defeated the Thoroughbreds of Newport Central Catholic 83-57 to capture the girls' championship and the Mustangs of Bishop Brossart downed the Bardstown Tigers 56-48 to capture the boys' statewide championship on February 4.
- The organizing agency for the tournament is the Kentucky All "A" Classic, Incorporated. The tournament is hosted by Eastern Kentucky University and the City of Richmond. Tournament funding is provided by Touchstone Energy and the Kentucky All "A" Classic, Incorporated. Funds are generated through donations and ticket sales.
- Tickets for specific sessions can be purchased on game day for \$9.00 each at the ticket windows of McBrayer Arena. Questions regarding tickets or other information should be directed to the Eastern Kentucky University Athletic Ticket Office at (859) 622-2122.

HISTORY OF THE ALL "A" CLASSIC

Through the efforts of coaches such as Stan Steidel of Dayton, Bill Frey of Covington Holy Cross, Father Ed Heile of Covington Latin, and others, the inception of a small school basketball tournament began in January of 1980. The first Class "A" Tournament was held at Holy Cross High School in Latonia with nine teams. In 1981, the tournament moved to Bellevue with ten teams, all from northern Kentucky.

From 1982 to 1988, the Classic went statewide by inviting six and eventually eight Class "A" schools from around the state to compete with the ten northern Kentucky schools.

In 1990, the All "A" Classic experienced a dream come true! A statewide championship tournament occurred with 16 boys' regional tournament winners competing in Lexington in February. In 1991, the All "A" Classic expanded to include the field of 16 boys' regional winners and four girls' sectional winners competing in the statewide finals. In 1992, the statewide tournament again expanded to include 8 girls' teams and in 1993 included the full complement of 16 boys and 16 girls teams.
