## 2023 Kentucky All "A" Classic Volleyball Tournament

- 1. Teams should arrive at least 45 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time of their first match. Gates will open at 5:00 p.m. on Friday and 7:30 a.m. on Saturday.
- 2. There will be no pass gate. Teams should enter through the regular admission gate. Volleyball coaches and players will not need a pass to enter. Volleyball teams are limited to 15 team members to receive free admission.
- 3. Each team will be provided with five complimentary passes to be used for Principals, Athletic Directors, and Superintendents. No cards will be honored with the exception of media credentials. These complimentary passes will be available through GOFAN.
- 4. Warm-up volleyballs will not be provided so please bring your own.
- 5. The All "A" Classic will not provide any meal or hotel reimbursements for the statewide tournament this year. Teams must make their own hotel reservations.
- 6. Each team is responsible to provide a scorer, line judge, and libero tracker for each match during pool play. During tournament play registered officials will be utilized as line judges in the championship bracket but teams participating in the consolation bracket will provide line judges.
- 7. Teams may have a maximum of 15 players/managers in the bench area.
- 8. Fan admission price is \$10 on Friday night and \$10 on Saturday Children ages 3 and under shall be admitted free. tickets will be available through GOFAN. Re-entry is permitted for both days. Gates will open at 5:00 p.m. on Friday and 7:30 a.m. on Saturday. Wristbands will be required for reentry.
- 9. Parking on Friday night is available in the main McBrayer Arena parking lot. Saturday parking will not be available in the main McBrayer lot due to a home football game but will be available in the Commonwealth lot which located close to the two venues.

- 10. Tournament format is pool play followed by a singleelimination tournament. The top two teams in each pool will advance to the Championship Division Tournament while the third and fourth place teams in each pool will advance to a Consolation Round.
- 11. Pool play sets will be to 25 with a cap of 30. Tournament sets will be to 25 with no cap. Time between matches will be 3-3-1. All matches are the best two-out-of-three format.
- 12. Championship and runner-up team trophies will be awarded in the Championship Division. An all-tournament team will be named.
- 13. The team listed first in pool play and on the top bracket for tournament play will be considered the home team and will sit on the bench to the right of the scorers' table for their first set of the match.

- 15. Teams are encouraged to bring their own trainer as one will not be provided at the tournament. The trainer will be admitted free.
- 16. Tie-breaker procedure for pool play:
  - a. Head-to-head
  - b. Match record among teams tied
  - c. Sets won between teams tied
  - d. Points allowed between teams tied (first two sets of each match only)
  - e. Sets won overall
  - f. Points allowed overall (first two sets of each match
    only)
  - g. Blind draw (reverse alphabetical order)
    - Note: If the tie-breaker procedure results in the breaking of at least one but not all ties then the remaining tied teams should move back to (a) and start over.
