Rules

- **1.** USGA rules will govern all play.
- 2. All players will play from the Blue Tee Markers
- **3.** Out of bounds is defined by white stakes/lines, boundary fences, and parking lots.
- **4.** Penalty areas are defined by yellow stakes/lines OR red stakes/lines.
- **5.** Ground under repair is marked with white paint. Ruts and washed-out areas along cart paths are considered ground under repair.
- **6.** Tall natural grass areas will be played as a **lateral penalty area** (tall grass left of the fairway on hole #8 is **out of bounds**).
- **7.** Please play a **provisional** ball if you think your ball may be lost or out of bounds.
- **8.** Any shot striking a power line MUST be replayed. All utility poles are played as obstructions and relief may only be taken if it interferes with your stance or swing.
- **9.** Distance measuring devices are permitted (devices that allow for slope adjustment are prohibited).
- **10.** A player who is uncertain about the correct procedure while playing a hole may complete the hole with two balls. The player must report the situation to a rules official before returning their scorecard.
- **11.** Coaches with a full team will receive a cart. Teams will also have the opportunity to reserve at most two additional carts. Coaches should provide the All A with the names of these two individuals (parents, grandparents etc.) It is the discretion of each coach to select these individuals. Coaches with individual players may also request one cart for rent with limited availability.
- **12. Pace of Play:** Set at 4 Hours and 30 minutes Circle 8 is available but may not be used in team totals.
- **13.** Late to Start: 5 minutes or less 2 stokes later disqualification.
- **14. Team Ties:** In case of a tie for 1st, 2nd, or 3rd, first tie breaker is the 5th golfer and if one team does not have a fifth golfer the team that does gets the tie-breaker, if still tied then the coaches will choose two golfers to represent their team and play #18 with a team combined low score being the winner
- **15. Individual Ties:** A tie for first, second, or third will be a sudden death playoff on hole #18 and they will continue to play hole #18 until a winner is determined.
- **16.** GGID's will be located at the bottom of your scorecards. Make sure to put in your score after every hole.
- **17.** If tournament is not completed on day scheduled no make-up date is available.
