

## 2026 ARCHERY GUIDELINES

1. The All "A" Archery tournament uses Arrow Scores which allows 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders to shoot on the high school team. This system's website is <https://arrowcores.com/>.
2. The Regional Archery Tournaments need to be finished by February 7, 2026 and the qualifying teams and individuals need to be sent to Rhonda Simpson by February 10, 2026 at [Rhonda.simpson@dawsonsprings.kyschools.us](mailto:Rhonda.simpson@dawsonsprings.kyschools.us) . Then each school needs to register on the Arrow Scores website for the state tournament. Registration opens in January. Please contact Rhonda Simpson or David Starks at [David.starks@hopkins.kyschools.us](mailto:David.starks@hopkins.kyschools.us) if you have any questions.
3. Each region can have two teams of 12 archers and the top five individual qualifiers not on a winning team. (Teams are co-ed with no limit on the number of girls or boys you have on a team) (Teams must be KHSAA approved or certified members) (Each school can enter only one team in the regional).
4. A region without two archery teams can send one 12-person team and the top eight individuals not from the winning team. (In this case the region can decide if they need to have a regional tournament).
5. If the region has no team entries, then the top 10 individual archers advance to the state tournament.
6. Cost for each archer at the state tournament will be \$10.00. A check from each school participating shall be brought to the state tournament the day of the tournament made out to the All A Classic. (\$120 team, \$10 per individual).
7. Admission for spectators will be \$11 per person on GoFan with anyone under 3 years old admitted free.
8. Awards will be First Place Team trophy and 2<sup>nd</sup> place team plaque. Individual champion will receive a plaque and runner-up through 10<sup>th</sup> place will receive a medallion.
9. Concessions will be available at the complex.
10. The tournament will take place on Saturday February 21, 2026. Flights will start at either 8:00 or 9:00 am. Central time. Each flight will take about an hour. Awards will be presented at the conclusion of the last flight.
