

Notice to Competitors
All "A" Classic Girls' Statewide Championship –Sunday, August 30, 2026

This information supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of the Competition, Pace of Play Guidelines/Procedures, and event entry form (if applicable).

Local Rule, Out-of-Bounds:

The new stroke-and-distance local rule allows players the option of dropping in the fairway if they so choose. Players must find where their ball went out of bounds and create an imaginary perpendicular to the fairway, no closer to the hole. From there, you can now drop anywhere within two club-lengths behind the line. The next shot will be your *fourth*.

Format: 18-Hole Stroke Play

Addendum: We will be playing lift, clean and place in the fairway only. Ball may be moved a scorecard length. The ball must be holed.

Teeing Ground: All Play will occur from the **White** Tee Markers

Drop Zones: Drop Zones will be used on holes #2, #14, #15 and #16 as an option for a ball hit into penalty areas.

Out of Bounds: Rule 18...Defined by White Stakes and/or lines, white perimeter fencing or public roads inside the boundary of the golf course. The ball is considered Out of Bounds even if it comes to rest on another part of the property if it crosses the public road.

Red Penalty Area: Rule 17...Defined by Red Lines and designated by Red Stakes that are moveable obstructions.

Ground Under Repair: Rule 16 Abnormal Ground Conditions...Defined by White Lines... Bunker on left of 18 and 5 green has dead spot. Others areas of GUR that are not marked include: French Drains (trenches filled with gravel or other rock) ant beds or mounds caused by burrowing animals, or seams surrounding sodded areas.

Embedded Ball: Rule 16...The "Embedded Ball Rule" as written is in effect "through the green".

Doubt as to Procedure: Rule 3-3...In a stroke play event when a competitor is doubtful of the procedure, he may complete the hole playing two balls. The player **MUST** report the facts of the situation before the score card is signed.

Suspension of Play: A suspension of play for a dangerous situation will be signaled by one long air horn blast. All play is to be stopped immediately. A resumption of play will be signaled by two air horn blasts. If serious weather is the cause for suspension all players will be shuttled to the Mule Barn.

Distance Measuring Devices: Players may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. Measuring device may not measure wind or slope.

Pace of Play: Please maintain Pace of Play and position with the group immediately ahead of you.

Advice: **Designated Coaches are the only ones permitted to give advice and must follow the current coaching rule.** Coaches are NOT permitted to be on the putting greens. Coaches shall be designated.

Movable Obstructions: Stones in bunkers are considered moveable obstructions (Rule 15 applies).

Team Ties: In case of a tie for 1st, 2nd the first tie breaker will be the 5th player's score. If a team does not have a 5th player, the team that does will win the tiebreaker. If this does not break the tie, then the coach will pick 2 players from his/her team to represent the team in a sudden death playoff on hole #18. Both players' scores will be totaled together, and the team with the lowest score will win the tie.

Individual Ties: In the event there is a tie for Individual event, there will be a playoff at the conclusion of play starting on 18 and playing sudden death until we can declare a winner.
